Late Winter Greetings to Our TFS Families,

I am so excited about turning our clocks forward next week: March 14, 2010. That simple action means longer daylight hours, warmer days, daffodils poking out and finally shedding those heavy winter coats. I hope you look forward to early spring as much as I do.

As we think about the outdoors, I want to take a moment to point out a safety concern very important to us at TFS. The movement of students through our parking lots is one that requires the utmost diligence by all adults. When we walk with children to the busses, they hold an adult's hand, walk as far away from the road as possible, and make sure that no busses move while children are on the sidewalks. As a staff, we feel this is the best way to protect the children in our care.

Additionally, when moving through our parking lots, children should be holding the hands of an adult at all times for their safety. We have students coming and going in our parking lots all day long: arrival, late arrivals, doctor appointments, sick children, and dismissals. If a child is running ahead of their adult, they are difficult to see and could be hit by another car, bus or delivery truck in the driveway. Please safeguard your child and ask them to hold your hand when exiting the building. We teach them this at any other time they are in the vehicle areas with our staff, and ask you to do the same when they are arriving or leaving with you.

We want all of our little folks to be around to enjoy the great details of spring: T-Ball games, green grass, and sunshine.
