Hello to our TFS Families and Happy Friday,

By the time you read this, we will be saying good-bye to April and diving headlong into May. Visions of T-Ball practices, Mother's Day and end of year assessments are dancing through my head. Many parents found this out last August when the bus did not pick their child up the first day so we are trying to remind as many parents as possible to alleviate this problem.

One other reminder for all of us is the start time of school each day. Our teaching staff plans diligently to squeeze fun learning activities into every minute possible. All special services and supports begin with the start of the school day as well. While arriving 10-20 minutes late may not seem like a great deal of time, think about the activity your child may be missing. Yesterday I observed a Pre-K student dragging his grown-up out of the office telling her, "Hurry, hurry, I don't want to miss Circle Time, it is my turn to use pointer today". Perhaps not a big issue for us as adults, but this event is monumental in the eyes of a four year old.
