From the Lunchroom:

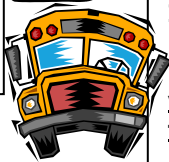
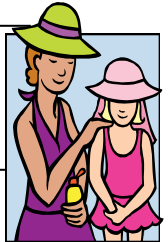
Please remember to pay for the field day lunches by Monday. Thanks!
