Important News from the Nurse's Office

Parents with students who have medications at school need to pick up the medicine by the end of school.

Students born in 2003, going to kindergarten in the fall need to turn in an updated kindergarten physical (physical less than 1 year old by Sept. 2008). Kindergarten students also need to receive kindergarten booster vaccines. Please check with your physician regarding updated vaccines. If your next physical is not due until after Sept. 2008, the one currently turned in to the nurse is acceptable for kindergarten, but booster shots need to be done before the first day of school.

For students with medications, continuing next year at TFS, written doctors' orders for medications are good for one year. Parents need to provide a new written order for fall, when they bring back students medications for school.
