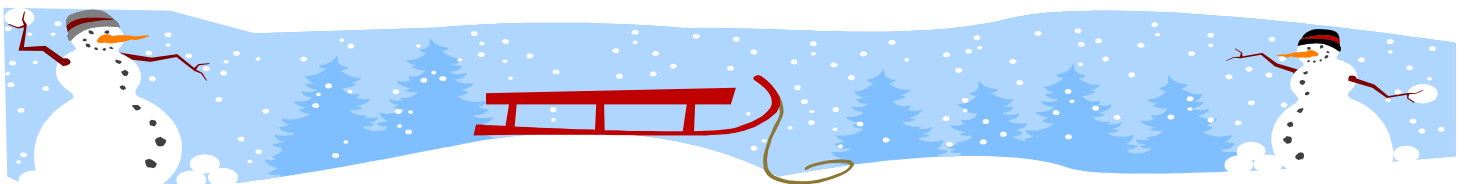

Dear Parents,

Well, we made it through our first snow storm of the winter and I was able to send our first "real" message to all of you bright and early yesterday and today using our new electronic notification system. Hopefully, you all received the news early enough to make arrangements for childcare if you work or to let the children sleep in rather than waking up early for school. We'll continue using this method to let you know about school delays and cancellations and also to remind you about important events, such as meetings, conferences, report cards, gatherings and celebrations. Little by little we are getting correct contact numbers for the few of you whose numbers has changed since we last recorded them at school. After yesterday's "No School" message was sent we receive a report of about 30 numbers called unsuccessfully. That wasn't bad considering that there are 520 children in the school. If yours was one of those numbers you will received a letter from the office asking for alternate contact information because we really do want you to receive important notices. Of course, if you would like your number removed from the call list, just let us know by calling the front office or sending in a note with your child. If there is a power failure where this message originates, you should tune in to a local TV or radio station for schools delays, cancellations or early dismissal information. Either way, we need to have the most up-to-date contact information in the office in case of emergency. So, that was the big deal yesterday. The new notification system worked. I hope you and your children had a nice day yesterday and that you didn't have to go out except to have fun in the snow when it first began. It looks like there may be more snow to play in this weekend. Stay tuned!
